

## Policy | Films, Videos, DVDs and Computer Games

## **Rationale**

**Monaro High School** recognises the use of films, videos, DVDs and computer games as a valuable teaching and learning resource.

Monaro High School complies with the National Classification Scheme (NCS) and follows all recommended ratings.

In general, films and computer games are classified as G, PG, M and MA 15+. Films may also be classified R 18+. G, PG, and M are advisory classifications recommending the appropriate audience. MA 15+ and R 18+ are legally restricted catergories.

## **Guidelines**

- All film and computer games must be previewed by teachers prior to use with students.
- **G, PG**, and **M** are **advisory classifications**, recommending the appropriate audience.
- MA15+ and R18+ are legally restricted categories.
- Use of any classified (from G through to MA15+) materials requires the approval of the Principal.
- The Principal may delegate the approval of the use of G and PG material to an appropriate member of the teaching staff.
- PG material should only be used with students after careful consideration. Staff may wish to inform parents prior to viewing.
- ONLY THE PRINCIPAL can approve materials rated M and MA15+. These materials must be:
  - Relevant to the course;
  - Only used when other related resources are limited;

- Only used with students who are 15 years and over;
- Only used after parents have been notified (note home with Principal's signature)
- The Principal may delegate the task of viewing M and MA15+ materials to an appropriate member of the teaching staff, who can advise as to the suitability of the material. However, ONLY THE PRINCIPAL can approve the showing of these materials to students.
- Parents must be informed in writing for both M and MA15+.
  - For Year 11 and 12 students, informing parents in advance may be notification to parents at the start of a course that M-classified materials may be shown during the course. For MA15+, parents must respond with their writtend approval. Students who are 18 years or older AND living apart from parent supervision may sign their own approval.
- NO FILMS CLASSIFIED R18+ ARE TO BE SHOWN TO SCHOOL STUDENTS UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCES.

## **Evaluation**

This policy will be reviewed as part of the school's three-year review cycle.
